- *ἱκανᾶτος, ου, ὁ, commonly οἱ ἱκανᾶτοι, hikanati, a body of picked soldiers so called. Const. IV, 784 A. Nicet. Paphl. 492 B. Porph. Them. 26, 16. Adm. 226, 16. Cer. 61, 17. 460, 13. 484, 15. 489, 6 ὁ ἱκανᾶτος = οἱ ἱκανᾶτοι collectively considered. Theoph. Cont. 20, 5. 389 τὸ ἱκανᾶτον = οἱ ἱκανᾶτοι.*

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### Ετυμολογία:

- Από το ἱκανός

*Ἰκανός, from ἱκάνω, ἱκανῶ, or from ἴκω, (as σφεδα-ΝΟΣ,) venio, to come, as we say, Be-coming, Come-ly, Con-venient from Venio, i.e. agreeable to one's wants, as 'Give me food con-venient for me', i.e. enough : So we speak of the con-veniences of life. Thus a fitting time is Ἰκνούμενον, a suitable time or hour Ἰκνούμενα. 'Reaching to what is desired :' Ormst. 'Coming without impediments, prepared :' Damm. Better, Coming up to the mark.*
