†Κάρουρα, ων, τᾶ, Carūra, a city on the borders of Phrygia and Caria, Strab.

Κᾶρόω, ᾶ, f. -ώσω, (κύρος) to plunge into deep, heavy sleep, to stupify, make dizzy, of wine, Αναξανδρ. Ἄγροικ. 2. Pass. to be torpid, feel heavy in the head, Arist. H. A.

Κᾶρώδης, ες, (κύρος, εἶδος) drowsy, heavy, Hipp.

Κύρωσις, εως, ἦ, (καρόω) heaviness in the head, drowsiness, Hipp. [ᾶ] Hence

Κᾶρωτίδες, ων, αἶ, the carotids, the two great arteries of the neck, Arist. H. A.

Κᾶρωτικός, ἦ, ὄν, (καρόω) stupifying, soporific, Galen.—II. καρωτικά ἄρτηρίαι, = καρωτίδες.

Κᾶρωτόν, οὔ, τό, a carot, Ath.
