αἰνίσσομαι, Att. αἰνί-ττομαι: fut. -ίξομαι: aor. ἤνιξάμην : (αἴνος):— speak darkly or in riddles, μῶνήνξάμην; [S.Aj.1158](#); λόγοισικρυπτοῖσιν αἱ. [E.Ion430](#); γνωρίμως αἰνίξομαι so as to be understood, [Id.EI.946](#); c. acc. cogn., λόγον . . αἰνίξατο [Pi.P.8.40](#); αἰνίσσεσθαι ἔπεα to speak riddling verses, [Hdt.5.56](#); c. acc. rei, hint a thing, intimate, shadow forth, [Pl.Ap.21b](#), [Tht.152c](#); τὸ δίκαιον ὁ εἴη [R.332b](#); ὅτι . . [Phd.69c](#); αἱ. εἰς . . to refer as in a riddle to, to hint at, εἰς Κλέωνα τοῦτ' αἰνίττεται [Ar.Pax47](#); τὴν Κυλλήνην . . εἰς τὴν χεῖρ' ὄρθως ἤνιξατο used the riddling word Cyllene (cf. κυλλός) . ., [Id.Eq.1085](#); so ἤνιξαθ' ὁ Βάκις τοῦτο πρὸς τὸν ἀέρα [Id.Av.970](#); αἰνιττόμενος εἰς ἐμέ [Aeschin.2.108](#); αἱ. ὡς..
